An Important Role



As precinct committeeman you can:

Help recruit new precinct members!

Attend precinct meetings!

Represent your precinct at the county level by voting in business meetings!

Gain the skills needed to seek election to county-wide party office!

Participate in election integrity efforts!

Help recruit Constitutional candidates!

Participate in the county convention!

Why a precinct strategy?

Because neighbor to neighbor works!

(Name) County is divided into **xxx** precincts. Each of those precincts should elect an Executive Committeeperson AND a Precinct President, and then go on to elect other officers and members. As precinct committeeman, it's your top priority and responsibility to vote your precinct's wishes at the county meetings.

But that's not all you do!

Each precinct is an opportunity for grassroots involvement. The key is to grow the number of members in each community. But it's not just about numbers! You, your neighbors, and your friends will empower each other to stand up for America!

Here are some of the important goals for our precinct committeemen:

- Attend precinct meetings and listen to your neighbors. Get to know where they stand on the issues.
- As committeeman, you will reflect the views and desires of the precinct members when voting at the executive committee meetings held periodically at the county level.
- Precincts can sponsor resolutions on important issues to be voted on at the county level. Either you or the precinct president can bring resolutions to the county Resolutions Committee for consideration.
- Get prepared and knowledgeable; be ready for county party reorganization and elect a slate of officers who are likeminded with you and your precinct members! Know the process so that you are ready for success!

Precincts Are Classrooms

Our precincts are where we can "grow" delegates to the county convention (every two years), new county leadership, and candidates for elected office!

Members learn and experience grassroots involvement and gain the skills to be candidates for elected office; they'll learn the importance of staying "grounded" and responsive to the folks in their area. As precinct committeeperson, you and the president have the responsibility to make sure the precinct's voice is heard.

Representative democracy can be "messy," but our discussions and votes ensure that we work together to preserve our freedoms and our Constitution.
